

CIHEAM Scholarships

You are a citizen of a CIHEAM member state

The Institute adopts a new scholarship scheme that will allow more students to benefit from the bearing of the living costs and the training fees.

The full scholarship

If the selection committee ranked your application among the top, and depending on the number of available scholarships for each specialty and by country, you will be able to benefit from a **full scholarship**.

The CIHEAM-IAMM will cover the following costs:

- The training fees
- The medical and hospital insurance
- The accommodation in the CIHEAM-IAMM residence (Single room in double studio. Possibility of accommodation in a single studio with an additional cost to be paid by the student)
- Lunch at the CIHEAM-IAMM cafeteria on working days (from Monday to Friday, excluding the fixed closed periods)
- Additional allowance for living costs in Montpellier

You will cover the following costs:

- Registration fees : 230 euros
- The travel expenses (round trip)
- Your breakfasts and dinners

NB: If you are entitled to the scholarship of another institution, or if you are awaiting an answer from another institution, you must indicate this information in your application form.

The partial scholarship

The citizens of a CIHEAM Member State who are admitted in the Institute, but not entitled to a full scholarship, automatically benefit from a partial scholarship that bears the cost of the training fees.

You will cover the following costs:

- Registration fees : 230 euros
- The medical and hospital insurance (you can expect to pay around 250 euros if you subscribe to an insurance in France)
- The travel expenses (round trip)
- Your breakfasts and dinners

You are not a citizen of a CIHEAM member state

You cannot benefit from a scholarship granted by our Institute. **You will have to find a scholarship granted by the French cooperation or an international institution that covers the cost of your training.**

For this purpose, you need to contact the Cultural Advisor at the French Embassy in your country (Mission of Scientific and Technical Cooperation) and the administrations of other national and international institutions such as the AFD, the GTZ, the World Bank, the European Union

Note: very often, you need to submit your scholarship application one year ahead. We advise you to send us your application as soon as possible.

If the selection committee considers that you are eligible, we will address you a temporary admission that the funding organisations will ask you to provide. You will be given the final admission in June, under the condition that your application be definitely validated by the final selection committee.
